VIII. New Business: Discussion and Possible Action

Item A: Discuss and Consider a Resolution Authorizing Publication of Notice of Intention to Issue Certificates of Obligation

Alderman Ehmann explained the resolution was written by the Financial Advisors, Hal George confirmed the resolution meets the legal requirements. Alderman Ehmann made the motion to approve Resolution 13-251 Authorizing Publication of Notice of Intention to Issue Certificates of Obligation. Alderman Tucker seconded the motion. Item B: Discuss citizen's concern of bulk heading along canal

Nancy Carter explained her concerns with the standing water on S Sandpiper. One piece of property does not have a bulk head and the water comes up to the street. She asked if the property owner could either put in some type of bulk head or add fill to the lot; or if an ordinance could be put in place to help with health issues like standing water. Mayor Gillespie stated the City could not force property owners to place bulk heads on private property. Discussion occurred concerning correcting any drainage problems that may be in the area and possible road repairs to build up the street. No action was taken.
