

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO COASTAL BEND CABLEVISION CORP.,
A CORPORATION DULY INCORPORATED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE
STATE OF TEXAS, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, A CABLE
TELEVISION FRANCHISE; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE
BAY:

SECTION 1: That there is hereby granted to Coastal Bend
Cablevision Corp., its successors and assigns, herein called the
"Grantee," the right, privilege, and franchise until January 1,
2007, to construct, maintain, and operate in the present and future
streets, alleys, easements and public places of the City of
Ingleside on the Bay, Texas, as the limits of said City now exist
and as they may hereafter be extended, and its successors, cable
television lines, wires, and poles with all necessary or desirable
appurtenances (including underground conduits, poles, towers,
wires and transmission lines) for the purpose of supplying cable
television service to the said City, the inhabitants thereof, and
persons and corporations within and beyond the limits thereof, for
cable television service.

SECTION 2: Poles, towers, wires, and conduits shall be
erected so as not to interfere unreasonable with traffic over
streets and alleys, easements and the City may make and impose
reasonable requirements fixing the location of poles, towers,
wires, and conduits, provided that no such requirement shall be
unreasonably burdensome upon Grantee or unreasonably interfere with
the proper operation of said facilities.

SECTION 3: The service furnished hereunder to said City and its inhabitants shall be first-class in all respects considering all circumstances and shall be subject to such reasonable rules and regulations as the Grantee shall make from time to time. The Grantee may require reasonable security for the payment of its bills and reasonable fee in connection with furnishing said service.

SECTION 4: The Grantee shall hold the City harmless of and from all expense or liability for any act of negligence or misconduct of the Grantee hereunder.


SECTION 5: For and as full consideration and compensation for this franchise and the rights, privileges, and easements granted and conferred thereby and as rental for the use of the streets, alleys, easements and other public areas within or that may hereafter be within said City, the Grantee shall pay said City five percent (5%) of the Grantee's gross receipts from the sale of cable television service in and for use within the corporate limits of the City of Ingleside on the Bay commencing April, 1992, and for each month thereafter throughout the remainder of the term herein provided for, with each such payment to be made within 30 days of the close of Grantee's fiscal quarters. If Grantee should agree to pay to any other municipality which it serves a greater percentage than five percent (5%) of its said gross receipts, Grantee will automatically thereafter pay to the City of Ingleside on the Bay the same percentage of its gross receipts within the City of Ingleside on the Bay derived from the sale of cable television service. Provided such payments are legal.

SECTION 6: This franchise is not exclusive and nothing contained herein shall be construed to prevent the City from granting a franchise to any other person, firm, or corporation. Provided such franchise is on terms no more favorable or less burdensome than provided herein.

SECTION 7: This grant is conditioned that the Grantee shall file its written acceptance of this franchise within ninety (90) days after the adoption of this ordinance.

SECTION 8: The City Secretary is hereby authorized to publish this Ordinance by publishing the caption hereof in the official newspaper.

SECTION 1: LINE 4 change date to 2017 so all franchises will be of equal time periods.

LINE 5 add easements after alleys

SECTION 2: LINE 3 add easements after alleys

SECTION 4: LINE 2 strike or neglect insert, of negligence or misconduct.

SECTION 5: LINE 4 add easements after alleys

LINE 5 strike four percent (4%) insert five percent (5%)

LINE 8 strike for the month of insert commencing

LINE 10&11 strike on the first day of the second succeeding month insert within 30 days of the close of grantee's fiscal quarters. This is a request by our accounting group so that all franchise fee's could be paid quarterly.

LINE 13 strike four percent (4%) insert five percent (5%)

line 17 after service add provided such payments are legal.

SECTION 6: LINE 3 strike other like or similar rights and privileges insert a franchise

LINE 4 after corporation add provided such franchise is on terms no more favorable or less burdensome than provided herein.


