## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY FIRE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, fire protection is currently provided to the citizens of Ingleside on the Bay by the Volunteer Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ingleside on the Bay desires to provide such fire protection through the municipality; and

WHEREAS, the provision of fire protection is in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, and

WHEREAS, Ingleside on the Bay is authorized to provide such protection and desires to do so if the Volunteer Fire Department so decides.

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF INGLESDIE ON THE BAY:

Section 1. There is hereby established the Fire Department of Ingleside on the Bay. Such Department shall be staffed by volunteers and such Fire Department shall be responsible to the extent of their capabilities to provide fire protection and suppression duties. The Fire Chief shall be elected by the members of the Fire Department at an annual election for that purpose. The Fire Chief shall see to the training of the members of the Department and keep the City advised of the activities and needs of the Department.

Section 2. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept and receive on behalf of Ingleside on the Bay title to any and all equipment, goods, trucks, motor vehicles, or other property used and useful for the Fire Department and transferred, conveyed or given from the Volunteer Fire Department should such Volunteer Fire Department decide to make such transfer, conveyance or gift. The Mayor is authorized to

receive and accept such other equipment by gift, donation, conveyance, grant or other acquisition necessary or useful for the Fire Department.

Section 3. Nothing in this Ordinance creates or establishes any obligation or liability on the part of Ingleside on the Bay and the establishment of the Fire Department is dependent upon the Volunteer Fire Department taking such steps as are necessary and proper to transfer from a nonprofit corporation to the municipality.

# A RESOLUTION CONVEYING AND TRANSFERING ALL PROPERTY OF THE CORPORATION TO THE CITY OF INGLESIDE ON THE BAY; AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR SUCH TRANSFER

WHEREAS, On the Bay Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. was incorporated November 27, 1991; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Volunteer Fire Department is to acquire, operate and maintain fire fighting, rescue and other emergency equipment necessary for the preservation of life and the protection of property from and during fire or other emergencies with the area of its operation in San Patricio, County, Texas;

WHEREAS, the further purpose of the Volunteer Fire Department is to teach, educate and train citizens of said area in the art of the prevention and fighting of fires;

WHEREAS, from 1991 until the present said Volunteer Fire Department has operated and provided fire prevention and suppression services to the citizens and community of Ingleside on the Bay;

WHEREAS, from time to time said Volunteer Fire Department has acquired various motor vehicles, tools, equipment, fire suppression gear and other personal property used and useful to the purpose of the Department;

WHEREAS, after careful study and consideration of the operation of the Volunteer Fire Department it has been determined that the best interest of the citizens who are served by the Department is to transfer the property, equipment and operation of the Department to the City of Ingleside on the Bay;

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-laws the membership does not vote on the transfer of property and equipment but the membership has expressed the overwhelming desire to transfer the property, equipment and operation of the Department to the City of Ingleside on the Bay;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors is authorized to dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the stated purposes of the corporation that will insure continued fire protection and prevention in the area of this organization;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors hereby finds as a matter of fact that the transfer of the property, equipment and operation of the Department to the City of Ingleside on the Bay will insure continued fire protection and prevention in this area;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ingleside on the Bay passed and approved Ordinance No. 2002-01 on the 5th day of February, 2002 creating the City Fire Department to be staffed by members of the Volunteer Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, it is the in public interest, health and welfare for the Fire Department to be operated by the City of Ingleside on the Bay and staffed by the members of the Volunteer Fire Department and will insure continued fire protection and prevention in this area.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE ON THE BAY VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT, INC.:

Section 1. The functions and operations of the On the Bay Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. are hereby conveyed, transferred and given to the City of Ingleside on the Bay to operate the Fire Department as a City Department to be staffed by members of the On the Bay Volunteer Fire Department members in accordance with Ordinance No.

passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Ingleside on the Bay on the 5th day of February, 2002.

Section 2. Attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is a complete inventory of each and every, all and singular of the motor vehicles, tools, equipment, furniture and fixtures, fire suppression gear, and other personal property owned by the On the Bay Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. All of such equipment is hereby transferred, conveyed, granted and given to the City of Ingleside on the Bay to use to operate the Fire Department and such shall henceforth be City of Ingleside on the Bay property. The President of the On the Bay Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. is hereby authorized and directed to execute, sign and bind corporation on any and all documents, certificates of title, bills of sale or other document necessary to consummate this transfer.

Section 3. The On the Bay Volunteer Fire Department, Inc. will continue to operate and perform its purpose in accordance with said Ordinance No. 2002-01.
